BAE Systems to expand at Quantico Corporate Center

BAE Systems Land & Armaments LP has leased 12,182 square feet of office space at Quantico Corporate Center in Stafford County.

Around 40 engineering and program management professionals will work for the BAE Systems Land & Armaments division.

The division will be located in the second building, which will be completed this month. Site plan review is underway for the third building.

Last fall **BAE Systems Technology Solutions & Services Inc.**, a separate division, leased 33,055 square feet in the first building at the Quantico Corporate Center. It employs about 130 people there.

CresaPartners provided transaction and project management services to U.K.-based BAE Systems for the lease. Phillip Baxter and David Newman of Silver Companies represented the landlord.

Quantico Corporate Center, being developed by Fredericksburg-based Silver Cos., will include one million square feet of Class A office space.
