## BRAC at MCB Quantico

BRAC Commission Recommendation 131 directed that the Military Department Investigative Agencies co-locate at MCB Quantico NLT September 15, 2011.

The Agencies involved are:

- Defense Security Service (DSS), with DSS Academy
- Counterintelligence Field Activity (CIFA) with the Joint Counterintelligence Training Academy (JCTA)
- Headquarters Naval Criminal Investigative Service (HQ NCIS)
- Headquarters US Army Criminal Investigation Command (HQ USACIDC)
- Headquarters Air Force Office of Special Investigations (HQ AFOSI)

The Agencies will bring approximately 2658 additional people to Marine Corps Base Quantico (351 military, 1752 civilian, and 555 contractor with an additional student population average of 263 per day).
