Hensel Phelps starts Quantico facility

Hensel Phelps Construction Co. broke ground on a new military department facility on the Marine Corps Base in Quantico.

The \$312.5 million project is a collaboration between the Greeley, Colo.-based construction firm and Denver-based design firm **Fentress Architects**.

The team has worked together on 54 projects valued at over \$4.3 billion.

Hensel Phelps Construction Co. won the contract in July 2008.

Commissioned by the Naval Facilities Engineering Command, the project is scheduled to deliver in June 2011.

The 719,000 square-foot multi-story facility is being erected for Base Realignment and Closure purposes.

When complete, it will house the Military Department Investigative Agencies, which is composed of the Counterintelligence Field Activity, the Naval Criminal Investigative Services headquarters, the Air Force Office of Special Investigations headquarters, the Army Criminal Investigation Command headquarters and the Defense Security Service.

Fentress Architects' portfolio includes the nearby **National Museum of the Marine Corps** in Quantico and the Colorado Convention Center.
